### De Lancey Trophy

Awarded for performance in Championship events.

### Ken Guy Trophy

Awarded for performance in all age-group Individual Medley events.

### Heron Trophy

Awarded for performance in all team events.

### Harrison Trophy

Awarded for performance in all 200m age-group events.

Competitors must compete successfully in at least four of the five events.

Points are awarded for the time achieved in relation to the Age Group Best Time (AGBT) at the start of the event.

Each AGBT is set at 10,000 points.

For every 1/100 of a second a competitor's time is faster than the AGBT, one point shall be added and for every 1/100 of a second slower, one point shall be deducted.

A bonus of 100 points shall be awarded to any competitor whose time stands as a new AGBT at the end of an event.

Points from the best four events shall be aggregated to decide the winner.
